Smt. Justice Chitra Venkataraman (Retd.) graduated in Economics from Ethiraj College, Chennai, and in Bachelor of Law from Madras Law College, Chennai. She started her practice at Madras High Court and specialised in Direct and Indirect tax laws.

She was appointed as Government Pleader during the period 1991 to 1995 and thereafter as the standing counsel for Income Tax for about 10 years. She was elevated as Judge of Madras High Court in the year 2005 and retired in April 2014.

She is presently handling arbitration matters and providing opinion in taxation and commercial laws.

She also holds Independent Directorship at Lakshmi Machine Works Ltd, The Ramco Cements Limited, and Ramco Industries Limited.
